Faith & Vocation Fellowship

Faith and Vocation Fellowships at Lutheran Campus Ministry are designed to provide opportunities for students to:

- Serve in partner ministries, exploring the diverse ways Christians serve neighbors
- Develop a close community of faith in which to reflect on God's presence in daily life
- Grow in relationship with God through knowledge and faith practices

The Faith & Vocation Fellowship program is a year-long commitment of approximately 10 hours per week during the academic year, excluding finals (15 weeks per semester). Each Fellow will receive a stipend of \$400 per month September - May (9 months).

General Program Requirements

In addition to serving in their partner ministry sites, all Faith & Vocation Fellows will participate in two cohort meetings per month. Meetings will take place from 1pm to 3pm on Sunday afternoons. These meetings will include three parts:

- Time for group conversation and reflection on issues and topics inspired by experiences in service sites and daily life.
- Introduction to topics related to the Christian faith including Biblical Interpretation, Lutheran Theology and Practice, and Faith in Daily Life.
- A short time for collective spiritual practices based on ancient and contemporary forms of prayer such as contemplative prayer, mindfulness meditation, lectio divina (meditation on scripture), etc.

2021-2022 Cohort Meeting Dates & Other Required Events

The cohort will meet from 1pm to 3pm on the following Sundays:

In addition, all Faith & Vocation Fellows will participate in three 2-hour site visits per semester. These meetings will provide opportunities for Fellows to experience the various types of work that each participant is doing. The scheduling of these visits will take place the first week of each semester.

All participants are expected to participate in the fall Leadership Retreat, which will take place August 31 to September 2 at a nearby retreat center.

Youth Ministry Leader

Ministry Site: Luther Memorial Church, 1021 University Avenue (next door to LCM)

Mentor: Rev. John Worzala Dumke, Associate Pastor

Description: The Youth and Family Ministry Leader facilitates small groups for middle and high school students in the congregation. In addition to having primary responsibility for youth groups, the leader also serves with the youth and family ministry team and assists its other programming including Sunday School, Confirmation, and Family Group.

Schedule: Two or more Sunday evenings per month, participation in worship on Sunday mornings. Other times are negotiable.

Qualifications: Undergraduate student at UW-Madison, Edgewood College, or Madison College. Willingness to share faith and facilitate meaningful conversation. Experience leading youth in a church or Bible camp setting preferred.

Homeless Ministry Support Fellow

Ministry Site: Bethel Lutheran Church, 312 Wisconsin Avenue (near the Capitol Square)

Mentor: Bev Thom, Homeless Support Volunteer Coordinator

Description: Working alongside experienced volunteers, the Fellow builds relationships with the individuals who utilize Bethel's Homeless Support Ministry. Through serving in various roles such as receptionist, computer lab assistant, kitchen assistant, etc. the Fellow will build rapport with guests and contribute to a positive, caring environment.

Schedule: About 8 hours per week on Tuesdays and/or Thursdays from 8:30am to 4:30pm. Availability on Tuesday mornings is preferred in order to participate in the weekly Spiritual Support Group.

Qualifications: Welcoming personality, willingness to engage with challenging population, good sense of humor. Student pursuing a career in social justice, homeless issues, social work or counseling preferred.

Choral Scholars participate in the Luther Memorial Choir, develop musical leadership skills, and become visible participants in the life of the congregation. In addition, Choral Scholars may serve in other aspects of the congregation's worship and music programs.

Schedule: Rehearsals Thursday evening from 7pm to 9pm and Sunday Liturgy from 10:30am to Noon (warm-up at 10:00am) required. Other times as arranged with mentor / supervisor.

Qualifications: Interest in being a visible member of an intergenerational Lutheran community, strong and pleasing solo voice, high level of musicianship and skill, good communication and leadership skills. Audition required.
